

## **Fonts**

• Ensure fonts for body text have bold and italic styles

Use professional fonts if possible

- Mixing fonts
  - try not to use more than 2 fonts per document (max 3)
  - lower contrast > higher contrast

Fonts to avoid: Comic Sans, Arial, Verdana, etc.

# **Point Size**

- Optimal font size for
  - Print: 10–12 points
  - Web: 15–25 pixels (11.25–18.75 points)

# Line Spacing & Line Length

Optimal line spacing: 120–145 %

Optimal line length: 45–90 characters

• Optimal page margin: **3.5–5 cm** 

# Hyphens and Dashes

- Hyphen -
  - Word breaking at the end of a line
  - Some multipart words (cost-effective)
  - Phrasal adjectives (technical-writer's job)
- En dash -
  - Range of values (2010–2020; 15–30 °C)
  - Connection or contrast (conservative-liberal split)
- Em dash
  - Similar to comma, but stronger (and weaker than colon, semicolon or parentheses)
  - Use em dash—it looks professional.

# Some Tips

- Kerning—use if possible
- **Bold** x *italic*—use sparingly
- Never use <u>underline</u> for emphasis, or any other purpose
- White-space characters
  - Show to discover double spaces and other formatting errors
  - Use a nonbreaking space with numbers, physical units, and in other occasions to prevent awkward line breaks

# Some More Tips

- "Curly quotes" > "straight quotes"
- Apostrophe: '(same as closing single quote)
- $^{TM}$ ,  $^{R}$ ,  $^{C}$  > (TM), (R), (c)
- ... > ...
- 100%
- Use / mostly without spaces; but when separating multiple words compounds, it may be more clear with spaces before and after slash
  - low price/benefits x low price / benefits
